## Class Photos

## Asymptomatic COVID-19 Testing

Up to one third of individuals with coronavirus do not show symptoms. This is why asymptomatic testing is so important. To support this, adult household members of children in school can access home test kits to undertake LFD testing twice weekly. # Family Support

Could your child be entitled to a school meal?

Over the past year, many families have had a significant change in their financial circumstances. If your financial situation has changed due to the pandemic, your child may now qualify for Free School Meals (FSM).

Please note that all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are given a free lunch at school. This free lunch is known as Universal Free School Meals and is NOT a Free School Meal status that is issued by the local Authority.
