This Sunday 20th June, is Father's Day. Father's Day is a day to honour all the special male role models in our lives; fathers, step-fathers, uncles and grandfathers who have taken on the role of 'father' and shown us love and support.



The first ever Father's Day happened in 1908, when a West Virginian church held a special sermon honouring fathers, after 362 men died in a mining accident.



In 1909, the year after the 'Father's Day' in West Virginia, a woman called Sonora Smart Dodd made it her mission to set a national Father's Day. Mrs Dodd wanted to honour her father who was as a single parent who had raised his six children.



Britain actually followed America in celebrating Father's Day.

So when is Father's Day? Well it all depends on where you live in the world.



Many countries, including Spain, Italy and Croatia, celebrate Father's Day on March 19th. This is due to the links with Roman Catholicism that this date has. March 19th is the Feast Day of St Joseph, the husband of Mary and adoptive father to Jesus.



Mexico started celebrating Father's day in 1950.

These nations all celebrate Father's Day on the first Sunday of September; Australia, New Zealand, New Guinea and Fiji.

Did you know in Thailand, Father's Day is celebrated on the late King Bhumibol's birthday, on the 5th of December? King Bhumibol is seen as the father of Thailand, the country not only remembers him, but commemorates fathers everywhere.
