Secondary Admissions for September 2022

Yesterday Year 6 children brought home a letter containing a link to the London Borough of Waltham Forest electronic 'Starting Secondary School 2022' guide in preparation for applying for a secondary school place for September 2022. The guide should be read carefully to assist you in this important process. Applications should be made online at www.eadmissions.org.uk. The closing date for applications is **31st October 2021**.

If your child lives outside the London Borough of Waltham Forest but you still wish to make an application for any of its schools, you will need to apply to the local authority in which you live.

Please note: The parents of children who have an Educational Health Care Plan (EHCP) and live in the London Borough of Waltham Forest will be contacted by Special Needs Services regarding your choice of school.

Lost Uniform



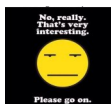
