### Covid Update

## Dear Parents/Carers

I write today with a COVID update.

Recorded rates of COVID have doubled in the last two weeks in Waltham Forest. This is broadly in line with London averages and below national rates. The true number is believed to be considerably higher as it is believed that not all of the population are now taking part in testing. Cases have increased the most in the 5 - 11 and 60+ age groups. At Chase Lane there has been strong evidence to support the reported trends and we continue to monitor them very closely.

On the 1st of April access to free PCR and LFD testing ends so this means that it is unlikely we will be able to ask children to be tested if they display symptoms linked to COVID. Schools are expecting new Health Protection guidance to be published that should include advise on respiratory conditions more generally and not just COVID. We are particularly interested to see if children and staff would be asked to isolate if showing such symptoms.

Currently, schools have not been issued with any updated guidance. This means that it is very difficult to plan for the summer term. It is expected that the current good practice of enhanced cleaning and excellent hand and respiratory hygiene are to be continued. This means that until further expectations are made clear that our current arrangements will remain in place. This may change in to the summer term as 'Living with the virus' becomes the new expectation.

As soon as I can provide any more useful information I will share with the school community accordingly.

In the meantime, have a great weekend, enjoy the sunshine and stay safe.
