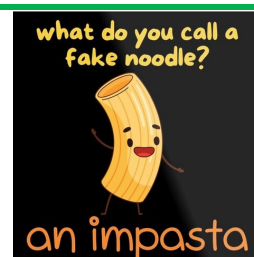

Eco News

Beavers have been re-introduced to London for the first time in more than 400 years thanks to a pioneering project launched by a London council and Capel Manor College, London's environmental college.

The two beavers - a male and female, both two years old - have been released into a specially designed enclosure within the grounds of Forty Hall Farm in London.

Beavers build leaky dams which help reduce flooding and also provide habitats for fish, small mammals, and insects, boosting biodiversity in the area. The study found that in the pools created by beaver dams, there were 37 percent more fish than in other stretches of the river where there were no dams.

Here are some amazing facts about beavers:

- They can remain underwater without breathing for up to 15 minutes
- Their front teeth never stop growing and are always orange.
- They have a third transparent eyelid that helps them see underwater.
- They are mostly nocturnal animals (they only come out at night).
- They are very good swimmers (thanks to their webbed feet) but are slow on land.



Vocabulary Corner

Biodiversity - The variety of living things in a given place, whether it is a small stream, a big desert, all the forests in the world, the oceans, or the entire planet—is called its **biodiversity**.

Example: The **biodiversity** of this lake is extremely high, with several dozen species of fish and birds living in or near it.

Dear Parents/Carers,

I write with a COVID update.

School continues to implement measures such as increased cleaning, excellent hand and respiratory hygiene and keeping the school well ventilated.

Despite this, a small number of cases have been identified over the past week. We currently have 5 members of staff and 3 children who have tested positive. The current recommendation is that if a member of staff tests positive, they isolate for 5 days and if a child tests positive, they should isolate for 3 days. Due to the current situation, if your child displays any sickness, diarrhoea, cough, colds or temperature we would recommend that you give them a COVID test. Unfortunately, school cannot provide these, but they can be purchased from local pharmacies.

Together, we continue to strive to keep our school community safe.
