World Chocolate Day

Yesterday Thursday 7th July was National Chocolate Day in the UK. National chocolate day celebrates the day in 1550 when chocolate was supposedly first brought to Europe.

Here are some interesting facts about chocolate:

Chocolate is made from the fruit of 'Cacao' trees. The fruits are called 'pods' and each pod contains around 40 cacao beans. The beans are dried and roasted to create cocoa bean

Cacao trees can live for up to 200 years!!

Chocolate has been around since ancient times. When we say ancient, we mean from the time of the Aztecs and the Mayans.

Chocolate gets it's name from the Aztec word 'xocoatl' that referred to a bitter and spicy drink made from cacao beans.

In Mayan times, cacao beans were used as currency and considered to be worth more than gold dust. At one time you could pay for things with chocolate instead of money!

70% of the world's cocoa beans come from four West African countries: Ivory Coast, Ghana, Nigeria and Cameroon.

Milk chocolate was invented in Switzerland.

White chocolate does not contain cocoa solids and so technically isn't chocolate at all.

Dark chocolate has lots of nutrients that are good for you.

Women's Euros 2022

It's an exciting time for football fans as the Union of European Football Associations (UEFA) Women's European Championship 2022 is officially underway. The competition started this week on Wednesday 6th July and continues through to Sunday 31st July.

The UEFA Women's European Football Championship (commonly known as the Women's Euros) is a football competition that takes place every four years.

This year, England will host the 2022 European Women's Championship and it will be held at 10 different stadiums across England. The other stadiums hosting matches will be Brentford, Brighton, Leigh (Leigh Sports Village), Manchester City (Academy Stadium), Milton Keynes, Rotherham, Sheffield (Bramall Lane) and Southampton.

As host, England will be joined by teams from 15 other nations across Europe and will compete to be crowned champions of Europe.

The Women's England football team are known as 'The Lionesses'. This week the Lionesses played their first match against Austria and won 1-0. England have made it to the final twice but never won the Euros. However, they have a new manager now and are playing really well as a team. On Monday 11th July England will play Norway and we wish them all the very best.
