On **Monday 10th July**, we will have our whole school transition day. Transition is where the children get to meet their new teacher for the new academic year 2023/2024.

Children will spend the whole day in their new classroom with their new teacher; this will include having lunch. They will come in to school and line up with their new class teacher. All class teachers will be holding up a name card with the class and teacher name clearly printed, so that you will know where your child will need to line up.



This year we are doing things slightly different and the children will also spend the mornings of **Tuesday 11th July and Wednesday 12th July** in their new classes.

Children moving from Year 2 to Year 3 will line up in the KS2 playground on all three mornings. They will then be taken to the main hall where the class teachers will take them safely up to their new classrooms.

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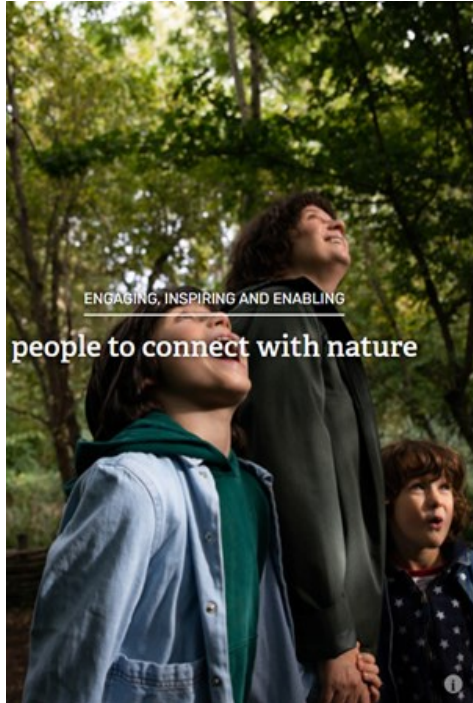


Walthamstow Wetlands
