Easter School

Year 6 Easter School Year 6 Parents are reminded that Easter School has been arranged for different groups of children to have extra lessons in Reading and Maths according to their particular needs. We want to ensure that all of our children are prepared for the Key Stage 2 SATs and are Secondary ready. Our very experienced teachers, who have all taught Year 6 children, will be taking the lessons. Children have been invited to attend one of the following groups:

1 week of Reading & Maths or 2 weeks of Reading & Maths

1 week of Reading only or 2 weeks of Reading only

1 week of Maths only or 2 weeks of Maths only

Maths sessions will run from 9.00am - 10.30am Reading sessions run from 10.30am -12.00 noon Reading & Maths sessions run from 9.00am - 12 noon

Week 1 runs from Tuesday 9th April - Friday 12th April and **Week 2** runs from Monday 15th April -Thursday 18th April.

Each day, the children will need to arrive promptly.
