

Year 4 - Home Learning Tasks

In the summer term, Year 4's topic will be Ancient Greeks. We will be looking at the history of the Ancient Greeks.

Here are some activities you can do together as a family.

- D&T Activity:

Using paper, cut it into small squares.
Use them to create a mosaic



- Geography Activity:

Mount Olympus is the highest mountain in Greece.

Research the Mount Olympus and create a poem/rap/song about:

- Where it is located
- Significance of Mount Olympus
- Name of the peak
- Describe what it looks like

- Art Activity:

Ancient Greek armies used shields to protect them in battles. They were full of intricate details. Using materials around the house, create your own shield.



- History Activity:

The Greeks were the first civilization to live by a democracy. The purpose of a democracy is that the majority rules. Can you ask these questions with family members (via phone, skype, facetime) and record their answers.

What is the majority vote in your family?

1. *Should schools finish at 2:30pm? Yes or no*
2. *Should all children have to eat vegetables? Yes or no*
3. *Should all children have to exercise daily? Yes or no*

- Science Activity:

'What are the ways in which electricity is generated?'

Research the different ways electricity can be generated using: internet, encyclopedias, books, google, talking to family members.

Answer the question above. You can present your answer in any way e.g. poster, song, rap, dance, written, pictures, performance, speech.
