determine a global winner, while also participating in fun activities that highlight the wonder of numbers. Children will automatically be able to take part in World Maths Day, just log in on the day and let the games begin!

The Live Mathletics challenges are the highlight of every World Maths Day. Students log into Mathletics and can compete against peers from around the world. The goal is simple: get as many questions correct as you can within one minute and be crowned the winning mathlete!

Winners then progress through to the global finals, which will take place two weeks after World Maths Day. They'll go head to head with others from around the world in a live-streamed knockout tournament, with prizes for the champions.

Vocabulary Corner




Incandescent = increasing in heat
