World Penguin Day

WORLD DAY

On Tuesday 25th April it was World Penguin Day, a day to appreciate and consider these remarkable aquatic birds and their place in our world. The day coincides with the annual northern migration of Antarctic penguins.

The day is aimed at raising awareness of penguins, many species of which are endangered. Currently there are a total of eighteen species of penguins and thirteen of these species are either listed as 'threatened' or 'endangered' .

Here are some fun facts about these amazing birds:

Penguins cannot fly - although they are birds and have wings, they can't fly. Penguins use their short, paddle like wings as flippers for swimming.

Penguins are skilled swimmers - Emperor penguins can swim up to 500m deep into the ocean and can stay underwater for up to 22 minutes.

The Gentoo penguin is the fastest species of penguin. It can swim up to 22 miles per hour.

Penguins are expert divers!

Penguins are highly social animals

Penguins poop every 20 minutes!

Once a year penguins lose ALL their feathers in one go - imagine losing your hair once a year? Don't worry - it always grows back two to three weeks later
