Universal FSM Important Announcement

In September 2023, the Mayor of London's scheme to provide Universal Free School (UFSM) to all children from Reception to Year 6 started. The scheme is currently only for one year. The scheme is very welcomed and it is calculated that families could save over £500 per year per child. As a school we have worked hard with Waltham Forest Catering to improve the quality of the school meals served and this has been very successful.



Currently we have about half of our children taking school meals and would like to see this increase and benefit more of our families.

From January 2024, in line with other schools in Waltham Forest, we will be making the change to serving Halal meat. This means that every child can have a hot meal and choose a meat option if they wish. We will continue to provide a vegetarian option each day and also

meet the needs of children who are vegan.

If you are still unsure about school meals, the catering team will be providing tasting sessions at the November parents evenings. Please do drop in to the canteen hall and have a taste of some of the foods on offer.

Remembrance Day, Lest We Forget

Every year the country comes together for Remembrance Day. Remembrance Day is celebrated to remember all of the people who died in World War I. It usually falls on the second Sunday in November. However, this year it falls on a Saturday.

Tomorrow Saturday 11th November 2023 will mark the actual day World War I ended, at 11am on the 11th day of the 11th month, in 1918. The first day of remembrance took place on November 11th 1919, one year after World War I ended. It was called Armistice Day.

This year marks the 70th anniversary of Remembrance Day.

Here are some facts about Remembrance Day:

- Poppies were chosen as a symbol because they often grew in the battlefields after the soldiers stopped fighting
- Poppies are usually bought and worn during a remembrance period that runs from the last Friday in October until the 11th
- All the monies raised from selling poppies goes to support serving and ex-service personnel and their families
- On Remembrance Day a two-minute silence is observed to remember those who lost their lives in conflict - this was requested by King George V on November 11, 1919
- Services of Remembrance are also held in many Commonwealth countries like Australia, Canada, India, New Zealand and some parts of the Caribbean
- The day also celebrates and supports veterans of combat that are still living
- A great way to honour the soldiers who fought in World War One is to listen to their stories and their experiences

Parent Governor Vacancies

We currently have two parent governor vacancies for the Chase Lane Primary School and Nursery Unit Governing Body.

The school, as you know, is led by myself (Mr Jeffery). I am supported a great deal by a wonderful board of school governors. The purpose of a school's governing body is to ensure that the

children and the community of Chase Lane are essentially getting the best deal possible. Collectively the governing body perform many tasks that support the school, hold the school/me (Mr Jeffery) to account and provide appropriate challenge to the school when necessary. The board is made up of a mix of people from a wide range of backgrounds with various skills and experience.

No special qualifications are needed and the Local Authority provide free training to all new governors. The key qualities to an excellent governor are to have a keen interest in the school and outcomes for the children. In addition, a governor will be available to play an active part in the Governing Body's work.

The school governors dedicate themselves voluntarily to approximately 10 meetings per year which take place on Tuesday evenings. Their commitment is immense and they are always well prepared for each meeting having read all relevant paperwork in advance.
