Year 4 South America


This term Year 4 are learning all about South America.

Measles Vaccination

Measles cases are rising in London. Measles is more than just a rash, it is a serious condition that spreads very easily and can lead to severe illness and even death. One in five measles cases may require a

hospital visit, and one in fifteen measles cases could cause complications such as meningitis, sepsis and blindness.

To check your child's status or to get them vaccinated, contact your GP. If you would prefer to attend an evening or weekend appointment, you can do so at one of the seven Primary Care hubs across Waltham Forest. Call 0208 519 3999 to book.






