

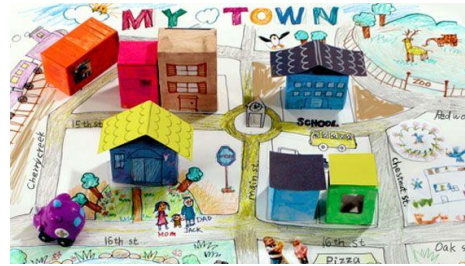
Year 3 - Home Learning Tasks

Here are some activities you can do together as a family.

- D&T Activity:

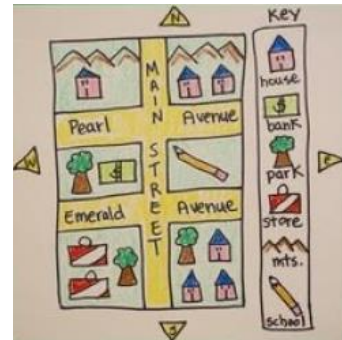
Using recycled materials, create a model of Chingford mount.



- Geography Activity:

Draw a map of your walk to school. Try to include landmarks, roads, houses and buildings you see (postbox, shops, zebra crossings, traffic lights etc)

Include a key.



- Art Activity:

We are looking at the artist May Morris (William Morris's daughter). You can use the internet to find out information about her. Use paint or colouring pencils to create a print inspired by May's art using flowers, trees, leaves and animals.



- History Activity:

Johnthan Ive was in Chingford. He is the chief designer at Apple. (He designed the Iphone!).

Use the internet to find out information about this local hero and design your own watch. You can be as creative as you want!

- Science Activity:

Gather some materials in your home.

Hold them up to the light or from your window. Observe, sort and record which materials are transparent, translucent and opaque.

Transparent - you are able to see through.

Translucent - you can partially see through and see shapes.

Opaque - you cannot see through.
