Geography Task:

1. Copy this website into your browser: https://www.ilibrarian.net/flagmaps/north_america.jpg
2. Draw the outline of a map of North America
3. Label the following major cities: **Mexico City, New York City, Los Angeles, Chicago, Toronto, Houston, Ecatepec de Morelos, Montreal, Philadelphia, , Guadalajara**
4. **Can you label the major geographical features: Rocky Mountains, Sierra Madres, Appalachian Mountains, Coastal Range, Great Plains, Canadian Shield, Coastal Plain**
5. Write sentences about each of the major geographical features that include the major city or cities they span across
6. Could you repeat steps 1-5 for London; labelling the major districts and landmarks?

Design Technology Task:

1. Inside a shoebox, or on some A4 card – build the inside of a typical home; including a TV, sofa, chest of drawers, rug, chairs, fireplace, vase, coffee table, candles, arm-chair, photo on the wall, dog, and fish-tank. (Do not stick these items to the surface)
2. Take a photo of your inside landscape looking tidy.
3. Find a vibrating surface such as the washing machine, dishwasher, or Hoover and place your inside landscape on-top of it.
4. Take a photo of your once tidy inside landscape looking as though it has encountered an earthquake.
5. **Answer this P4C Question:** If your bedroom encountered an earthquake, would you rather lose an inexpensive sentimental object, or an expensive item with no sentimental value?

Science Task:

1. Find a piece of fruit with seeds in it
2. Plant the seeds in three different locations, planted differently:
 - a. Seed 1 – in a cup, sitting on card, given water (dark place)
 - b. Seed 2 – in a cup, sitting on cotton wool, given water (dark place)
 - c. Seed 3 – in a cup, sitting in soil, given water (on window sill)
3. Make an informed prediction about each seeds growth, including the following words: carbon dioxide, photosynthesis, sunlight, germination, energy, roots and minerals
