#### FREE Hot Meal

We would like to start serving hot meals soon. To see if this will work, we will be having a trial day on Thursday 1st October where all children from Reception to Year 6 will receive a FREE hot meal.

If you would like your child to have a FREE hot meal on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> October, please let the school office know by **Monday 28th September**. Please share the menu with your child/children so that they can let their class teacher know their preferred option choice.

# COVID-19 Test

It is important that if your child (or anyone in your household) has any COVID-19 symptoms, they do not attend school and stay at home. You should inform the school immediately so that we can generate a code for you to book a COVID test. If your child presents symptoms whilst at school, we will send them and any other siblings home.

Your child (and any other siblings that attend Chase Lane) **must not** attend school until you receive a negative result. Please inform the school of the outcome of the test. Proof of a negative test result must be sent to the school **before** your child can return.

If you have a positive test result, your household should remain at home and follow the government 14 day self-isolation guidance.

#### Inhalers

It is very important that we <u>always</u> have blue inhalers in school for all children who have been diagnosed with asthma. Nursery children should always have one pump in the Nursery Unit, children in Reception - Year 2 should always have one pump in the main Welfare Room, and children in Years 3-6 should always have two pumps in school;- one pump in the main Welfare Room and another which is kept in their classroom. All parents of children diagnosed with asthma must inform the Welfare Officers in the school Office and have completed an Asthma Card to be kept in


the Welfare Room together with blue inhalers as detailed above - even if your child has not recently shown any symptoms.
